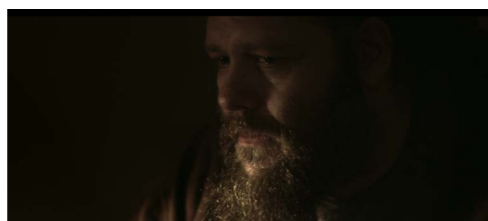

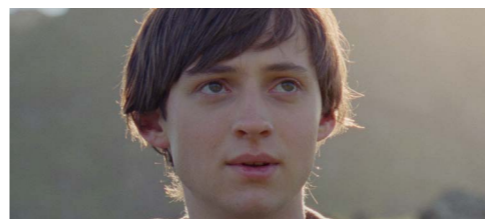

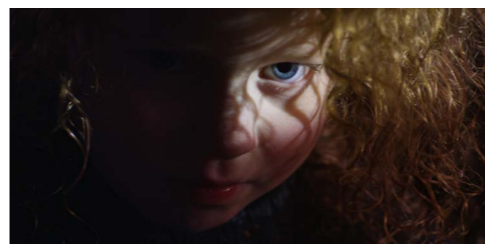

**HEATHER MILLARD**

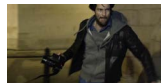
